Secure your PEPP PLANet account

Setting up security questions offers you a secure and convenient way of getting back into your online PEPP employer account if you forget your password or username. If you don't have questions set up, you can't use the Forgot Password or Forgot Username features so you'll have to contact a PEPP ERC. Set up your security questions under the *Profile* menu.

If you forgot your username, click the *Forgot Your Username* link and enter the email address associated with your PLANet account. An email will be sent to that account with a link and instructions.

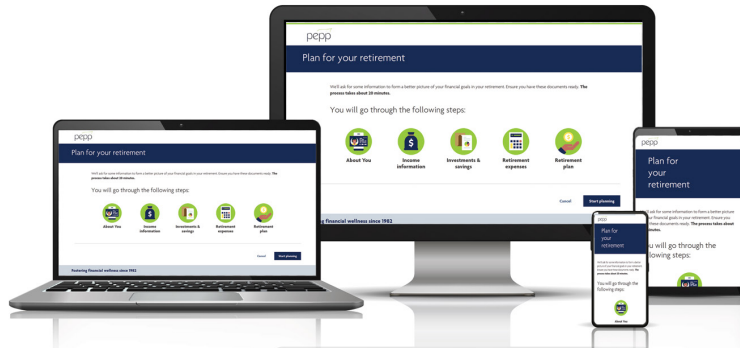
If you forgot your password, click the *Forgot Your Password* link. A password reset email will be sent to the email address associated with your PLANet account.

If you're locked out of your account, contact a PEPP ERC. An account is locked out after three unsuccessful login attempts.

To change your password, select *Change Password* from the *Profile* menu.

PEPP launches a new Retirement Planner



Recently, we launched the PEPP Retirement Planner, which is a secure, online tool designed to help members plan wisely for retirement. It helps take the guesswork out of retirement planning. This new tool replaces Retire@Ease.

To access the PEPP Retirement Planner, members will need to log in to their PLANet account for a seamless member experience. Then, select **PEPP Retirement Planner** in the *Quick Links* menu.

The PEPP Retirement Planner will give members the ability to:

- Estimate the savings they'll have available at retirement based on their current PEPP account balance and other assets;
- Calculate their expenses in retirement and experiment with different investment fund choices and scenarios that best suit their retirement goals;
- Assess their readiness for retirement;
- Create a personalized report showing how long their retirement savings may last;
- See their retirement score – which shows whether they're on track to meet their retirement goals; and
- Get recommendations to help members move closer to their retirement goals.
